Since 1965, **Port City Disabilities Services**, a division of Port City Enterprises, Inc., has been dedicated to helping children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities grow, connect, and live with greater independence. Based in Port Allen, we proudly serve families across East and West Baton Rouge, Pointe Coupee, Iberville Parishes, and beyond.

From our beginnings nearly 60 years ago, our mission has been rooted in one simple goal — to nurture growth, independence, and meaningful connections for every person we serve. Through a close-knit, family-centered approach, we've become a trusted partner to hundreds of families throughout our region.

Our programs are designed to meet individuals where they are and help them thrive:

- **Adult Day Care (Weekdays, 8 AM – 2 PM)** – for persons 17 and older. Our experienced staff fills the week with a variety of community activities including bowling, shopping, arts/music/cultural events, and dining out. At the center, clients enjoy computer games, bingo, basketball/tennis, and entrepreneurial projects like arts/crafts, woodworking, and gardening.
- **Job Training & Supported Employment** – for individuals who want to work part-time with a small crew and supervisor. The focus is on each person's strengths and abilities, plus opportunities to work out in the community alongside others without disabilities.
- **In-Home Supported Independent Living** – enabling individuals with special needs to live in their own homes for as long as possible. We provide individualized care on a 24-hour basis for persons living on their own, as well as part-time supports for those living with family or guardians.

In addition to these programs, **Port City currently creates a variety of crafts and artwork for purchase** at both the **West Baton Rouge Tourist Commission** and the **Port City Disabilities Services facility**. These unique, handcrafted items showcase the creativity and talents of our participants while helping to support ongoing programs and community engagement.

Port City also operates a thriving **bread-making program**, where our participants bake and package all of the bread rolls sold in Bergeron's Boudin & Cajun Meats markets. This ongoing partnership provides not only valuable vocational experience but also a powerful sense of purpose and accomplishment.

- **Future Project: Westside Sports League** – an **all-inclusive sports league for children and adults with special needs**. This upcoming initiative will bring together athletes of all abilities to participate in fun, structured, and adaptive sports programs designed to promote teamwork, confidence, physical health, and community connection. The Westside Sports League will foster



friendships and joy through sports while ensuring that every participant—regardless of ability—has the chance to shine.

• **Future Project: Greenhouse Project** – this planned program will allow participants to grow and care for plants that will be sold to the public. The hands-on experience will teach responsibility, patience, and entrepreneurship—skills that build confidence and prepare individuals for greater independence.

Fundraiser Event- The beloved **Angling Against Autism** fundraiser, presented by Bergeron’s Boudin & Cajun Meats. This annual Team Bass Tournament, held the first Saturday in March, has raised thousands of dollars to fund therapies, supplies, equipment, and services through the Arthur J. Bergeron and Lana Valley Estopinal Scholarship Funds. These funds help families cover critical expenses during the Medicaid waiver waiting period — ensuring that no one goes without care.
